1.	ARM	a part of the appendicular skeleton
2.	EAR	where the smallest bone in the body is located
3.	FEMUR	the largest bone in the human body
4.	SEVEN	the number of cervical (neck) vertebrae in the human body
5.	SACRUM	part of the vertebral collumn that is directly connected with or forms a part of the pelvis (and in humans consists of five fused vertebrae)
6.	AXIAL	forms the central axis of the body; includes skull, vertebrae, ribs
7.	SKULL	an example of a flat bone; also protects the brain
8.	JOINT	where two or more bones meet to allow or movement
9.	MUSCLES	the main tissues responsible for movement of a joint
10.	COCCYX	a small, triangular bone found at the base of the spine in humans
11.	CALCIUM	phosphate and stretchy collagen are the two main component of bone
12.	STIRRUP	the smallest bone in the human body; found in the ear
13.	STERNUM	another name for 'breast bone'
14.	TWELVE	the number of pairs of ribs in the human body
15.	LIGAMENT	a band of tough, fibrous tissue joining bones, cartilages at a joint or supporting an organ
16.	GROWING	these pains thought to affect the muscles and usually felt at night, affect children from ages 8-10
17.	THORACIC	the middle section of the spine where the ribs attach
18.	EPIPHYSIS	the rounded end of a long bone that is initially separated from the main bone by a layer of cartilage but later (after growth takes place) becomes united/ossified
