


Revise Skeleton vocabulary by completing this crossword.




Across Clues

- the light and dark transverse bands of skeletal muscles (10)
- 2) white blood cells which fight infection (10)
- a band of tough, fibrous tissue connecting a muscle to bone (6)
- 6) knee-cap; largest sesamoid bone in the human body (7)
- 10) these are protected by the polvis og liver, bladder, spleen (6)
- 11) these large cells are responsible for breakdown and resorption of old bone (12)
- 13) surrounds the outer surface of a bone (except at the extremeties) (10)
- 15) a band of tough, fibrous tissue joining bones, cartilage at a joint or supporting an organ (3)
- 16) this part of your spine contains the largest vertebrae to withstand large forces (6)
- 17) large white blood cell (10)
