Cross curriculum priority: sustainability


Science

Gather information on the effects of pollution on the growth of animals and humans. Present as a written report.
The growth and survival of living things are affected by the physical conditions of their environment (ACSSU094)
Cross curriculum priority: sustainability

Survey who ate a food containing calcium (helps to form bones and enhance growth) the day before. Groups take raw data and each present in a graph of a particular kind. Each group develops questions related to the graph, swap graph and another group answers the questions. Write what they learned about data and graphs that they didn't know before.

Could relate to any food or perhaps to another aspect of health enhancement – eg exercise.

Interpret and compare a range of data displays, including side-by-side column graphs for two categorical variables (ACMSP147)



Arts

Using the work in science, create short dialogues, mimes etc of the effect of pollution. Poems would be an appropriate resource. Emphasise the long term effect on growth.
Themes and improvisation
· Perform improvisations based on themes or characters from a text studied.

Read two short stories or novels which chart a 10-12 year old's psychological growth – understanding of an issue (aging, prejudice, illness)

Responding to literature
Analyse and evaluate similarities and differences in texts on similar topics, themes or plots (ACELT1614)

Write a short story in first or third person, where the central characters understands something about the adult world that he/she did not understand before. (Psychological growth)

Creating Literature
Create literary texts that adapt or combine aspects of texts students have experienced in innovative ways (ACELT1618)
Experiment with text structures and language features and their effects in creating

Health & Physical Education

Research the effects of certain chemicals including alcohol and their effects on human growth. Symptoms and first aid.
Concept: The impact of the environment on health.
Context: Identifying officers to avoid getting into dangers and for seeking help.
