## Column B

- ..... a part of the appendicular skeleton
- ..... where the smallest bone in the body is located
- ..... the largest bone in the human body
- ..... the number of cervical (neck) vertebrae in the human body
- ..... part of the vertebral column that is directly connected with or forms a part of the pelvis (and in humans consists of five fused vertebrae)
- ..... forms the central axis of the body; includes skull, vertebrae, ribs
- ..... an example of a flat bone; also protects the brain
- ..... where two or more bones meet to allow or movement
- ..... the main tissues responsible for movement of a joint
- ..... a small, triangular bone found at the base of the spine in humans
- ..... \_\_\_\_\_ phosphate and stretchy collagen are the two main component of bone
- ..... the smallest bone in the human body; found in the ear
- ..... another name for 'breast bone'
- ..... the number of pairs of ribs in the human body
- ..... a band of tough, fibrous tissue joining bones, cartilages at a joint or supporting an organ
- ..... these pains thought to affect the muscles and usually felt at night, affect children from ages 8-10
- ..... the middle section of the spine where the ribs attach
- ..... the rounded end of a long bone that is initially separated from the main bone by a layer of cartilage but later (after growth takes place) becomes united/ossified
- ..... a tough, fibrous connective tissue found in various parts of the body, eg joints
- ..... animal having a bony or cartilaginous skeleton
